

Polar Bear Paper Plate Craft



Supplies:

- Paper plates
- Cotton balls
- Elmer's glue
- Googly eyes
- Black pom poms
- Black pipe cleaners
- Scissors

Directions:

1. Glue 3 cotton balls together in a triangle shape to make an ear for your polar bear. Repeat this step for a second ear. Set aside to dry.
2. Cover a paper plate with glue and stick cotton balls on the plate entirely.
3. Glue googly eyes onto your bear.
4. Cut 2 pieces of black pipe cleaners approximately 3 inches long each.
5. Curve the end of both your pipe cleaners out and twist together the long straight part.
6. Glue the pipe cleaner mouth in the center of your plate a little towards the bottom.
7. Glue a black pom pom on the top end on your pipe cleaner mouth.
8. Glue your polar bear's ears on towards the top of your plate.
