Volunteer Overview

Camp Volunteers play an important role in creating a positive and engaging camp experience. Volunteers work alongside camp counselors, lead counselors, and specialists to assist campers, support daily activities, and contribute to a welcoming and inclusive environment.

This opportunity is ideal for individuals seeking meaningful, hands-on volunteer work that directly impacts the lives of children and teens with special needs in the St. Louis community. .

Commitment

- Duration and quantity of volunteer opportunities will vary during summer and winter break sessions and will be communicated for each session
- Typical camp hours: 8:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.
- Camp may be held at different locations through the St. Louis region each day
- *Volunteers of all abilities are welcome; however, individuals currently eligible to receive support from Variety are ineligible to volunteer.*

Volunteer Responsibilities

- Support a designated camp group (by age) under the direction of camp counselors and lead counselors.
- Support participation in daily activities by providing encouragement, modeling participation, and offering hands-on support when appropriate.
- Help create a fun, inclusive environment by promoting interaction and engagement among campers.
- Support smooth transitions between activities.
- Assist with setup and cleanup of activities and events.
- Work collaboratively with counselors, lead counselors, specialists, camp management and the management assistant to ensure a safe and positive experience for all campers.

Expectations for Volunteers

- Arrive on time and check in/out daily with camp management or management assistant and the assigned Lead Counselor.
- Communicate respectfully and appropriately with all staff, volunteers, campers, and families.
- Attend mandatory volunteer training.
- Adhere to all camp rules, policies, procedures, and safety guidelines.
- Follow directions from camp management and the management assistant and contribute to a positive, respectful, and safe camp culture.
- Complete a background check (required for all volunteers aged 18+).
- Track service hours if needed and submit verification paperwork to camp staff within two months of service completion.
- Minimum age requirement: 14 years old.
